



Red Carpet Readers: *The Book is Better than the Movie* East Lake Elementary School PTA Pick A Reading Partner 2020



What is PARP? PARP stands for “Pick A Reading Partner.” It’s a program that encourages adults to spend time reading at least 20 minutes a day with children.

East Lake’s 2020 PARP Theme: “Red Carpet Readers: The Book is Better than the Movie.” The theme is designed to help students understand how much more of the story is in a book compared to a movie.

Points: Students will earn “Stars” for their grade by participating in PARP. Here are the ways to earn stars:

- Submit your completed **reading contract** by **January 24th** (10 stars)
- Submit your **weekly reading log** (autograph book) **each Friday during PARP** -your child will receive the autograph book on 1/24 (10 stars)
- Submit a **bookmark** your child created by **January 24th** (5 stars)
- Attend **PARP events** (5 stars per event)- children should wear the **VIP passes** they will receive on 1/24:
 - **Red Carpet Kick-off- January 24th** at 6pm at East Lake
 - **Barnes & Noble Night- February 4th 4-8pm** at Barnes & Noble Massapequa
 - Borrow books from **Massapequa Public Libraries**- Bar Harbour & Central Ave and return the ticket you receive to the appropriate raffle basket (5 stars)- *This will also earn your child a raffle ticket for a chance to win a great raffle basket.*
- **PARP Selfies**- submit selfies of you and your child enjoying PARP activities together to EastLakePARP@yahoo.com. Make sure you include your child’s name and grade. (5 stars)
- **Dress-Up Day- February 7th**- Everyone is encouraged to come to school dressed as their favorite character from a book that’s also been made into a movie.
