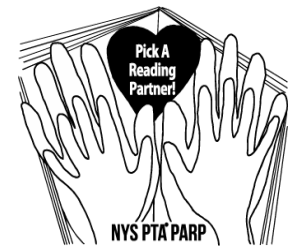

East Lake Elementary School PTA 2024 Pick A Reading Partner



Dear Parents,

Once again East Lake students will be participating in **PARP, Pick a Reading Partner** program. The PARP program encourages adults to spend time reading with their children. Just **15 minutes** a day will help them build their vocabulary, improve comprehension, and allow your children to expand their imagination.

This year's theme for PARP, "**Take a Journey Through Reading: Reading gives us Someplace to Go when we have to Stay where we are**", will kick off on Monday, February 5th with a visit and book signing from author, Dan Yaccarino.

This year, the students of each class will earn points for participation and help their grade earn points. Each GRADE has been assigned a mythical land from well-known books. The grade breakdown is as follows:

Hundred Acre Woods-Winnie the Pooh	Kindergarten (Mrs. Findlay's class)
Neverland- Peter Pan	First (Mrs. Gottlieb's class)
Wonderland- Alice in Wonderland	Second (Mrs. Sicignano's class)
Hogwarts- Harry Potter	Third
The Land of OZ - Wizard of OZ	Fourth
Narnia-The Lion Witch and the Wardrobe	Fifth (Including Mrs. Calvello's & Mrs. Guarini's class)

QR Code and PARP Materials: On the first day of PARP, students will receive a Postcard containing a QR code, and a compass with a mythical land map attached. The code is the only thing your child needs to participate in PARP! All materials will be found on the East Lake PTA website, which can be accessed through the QR code.

How to Earn Points and Raffle Tickets During PARP: As students participate in PARP activities, they will either earn points for their grade or receive a raffle ticket by visiting the public library.

Points can be earned by:

1. Signing & completing virtual reading contracts on the first day of PARP.
2. Completing the virtual reading logs each week.
3. Participating in one or all activities and events
 - Bring your compass and map to school.
 - Design a bookmark.
 - Fantasy MadLibs
 - Attending East Lake's book fair
 - Donating books to Book Fairies
 - Fairy Tale Puzzle
 - Fantasy Land themed dress up day
 - Super silly Valentine's joke contest.
 - Barnes & Noble secret reader event
4. Increased participation during library class with Ms. Schwen
5. Completing a short book report on books read throughout the two weeks.

The winning grades will be announced at the end of PARP (Friday, February 16th) and raffles will be completed throughout the two weeks.

PARP ACTIVITIES:

Bring your Compass and Map to School: Wear your Compass and/or Map to school throughout PARP. *Earn 1 Bonus Raffle Tickets from your teacher.*

The Student/Parent Contract: This virtual contract should be "signed" by **Monday February 5th.** *Earn 1 PARP Participation Point for your class.*

PARP Bookmarks: Students received a handout to create a “**Reading Journey,**” bookmark. They should return their decorated, cut out bookmark to their teacher by **Tuesday, February 6th**. Bookmarks will be voted on by peers and the winning design will be made into prizes. *Earn 1 PARP Participation Point for your class.*

Fantasy Land MadLibs: Complete & Submit Fantasy Land MadLibs to their teachers by **Wednesday, February 7th**. *Earn 1 PARP Participation Point for your class.*

Book Fair: *Separate flyer will go out with details. Earn 1 PARP Participation Point for your class with a book donation to Book Fairies.*

Fairytale Puzzle: Complete Fairytale Puzzle by **Thursday, February 8th**. *Earn 1 PARP Participation Point for your class.*

Dress Up Day: On **Thursday, February 8th** Dress like a character from your assigned fantasy land. *Earn 1 PARP Participation Point for your class.* Earn additional points if your child wears their costume to the evening Book Fair and Book Faires collection.

Valentine’s Day Super Silly Joke contest: Complete & submit your super silly Valentine’s day joke to the PTA Valentine’s Day box (Located by the PTA bulletin board) by **Wednesday, February 14th**. *Earn 1 PARP Participation Point for your class.*

Barnes and Noble Secret reader night: Stop by Barnes & Noble **Tuesday, February 13th** anytime from 4PM – 7PM and listen to various East Lake secret readers. Make sure to sign in at the PTA table upon arrival. *Earn 1 PARP Participation Point for your class.*

Visit The Massapequa Public Library at Central Avenue or Bar Harbour: Visit the library with your child and ask for an *East Lake raffle ticket* when checking out a book. Return it to your classroom teacher to be included with the PARP raffles.

The Reading Logs: These virtual logs should be completed at the end of each week - **Friday, February 9th and February 16th**. *Earn up to 100 Participation Points each week if everyone in your grade returns their completed reading log.*

Book Report (Optional): Submit up to 5 book reports per week on 2/9 and 2/15. Book Report templates for grades K-1, 2-3, and 4-5 have been provided.

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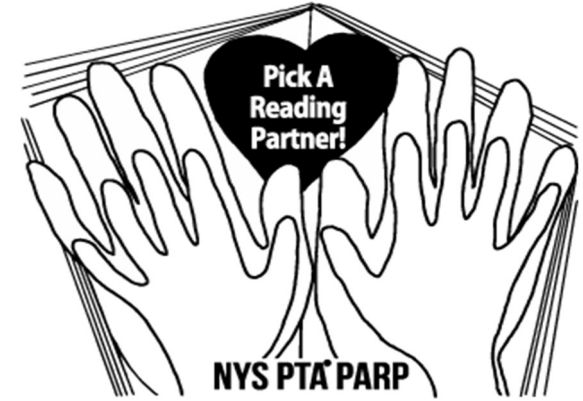
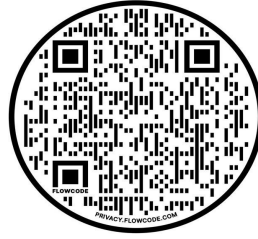
